Recommended Energy Savings Tips

PROGRAM YOUR THERMOSTAT

Setting your thermostat one degree lower when heating or one degree higher when cooling can reduce energy use up to 5%

LOADS OF LAUNDRY

Do full loads of laundry and wash with cold water. Using lukewarm water instead of hot can cut a load's energy use in half, and using cold water will save even more.

DOING THE DISHES

Air dry dishes whenever possible. This step can cut your dishwasher's energy use by up to 50%.

PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

In the most recent session the Utah State Legislature passed House Bill 66 (H.B. 66). The bill titled "Wildland Fire Planning and Cost Recovery Bill" aims to reduce the likelihood of electrical utility facilities starting a wildland fire. In accordance with the terms of H.B. 66, Garkane is preparing a draft, *Garkane Energy Wildland Fire Protection Plan*. It's a complex issue with no clear solution, but just as renewable energy generation sources have become more economically viable, I'm optimistic there will be energy storage options and other technologies that will continue to improve and we should be looking at these technologies to allow for the inevitable continued expansion of renewable energy power generation while preserving the reliable and consistent power supply we currently enjoy.
